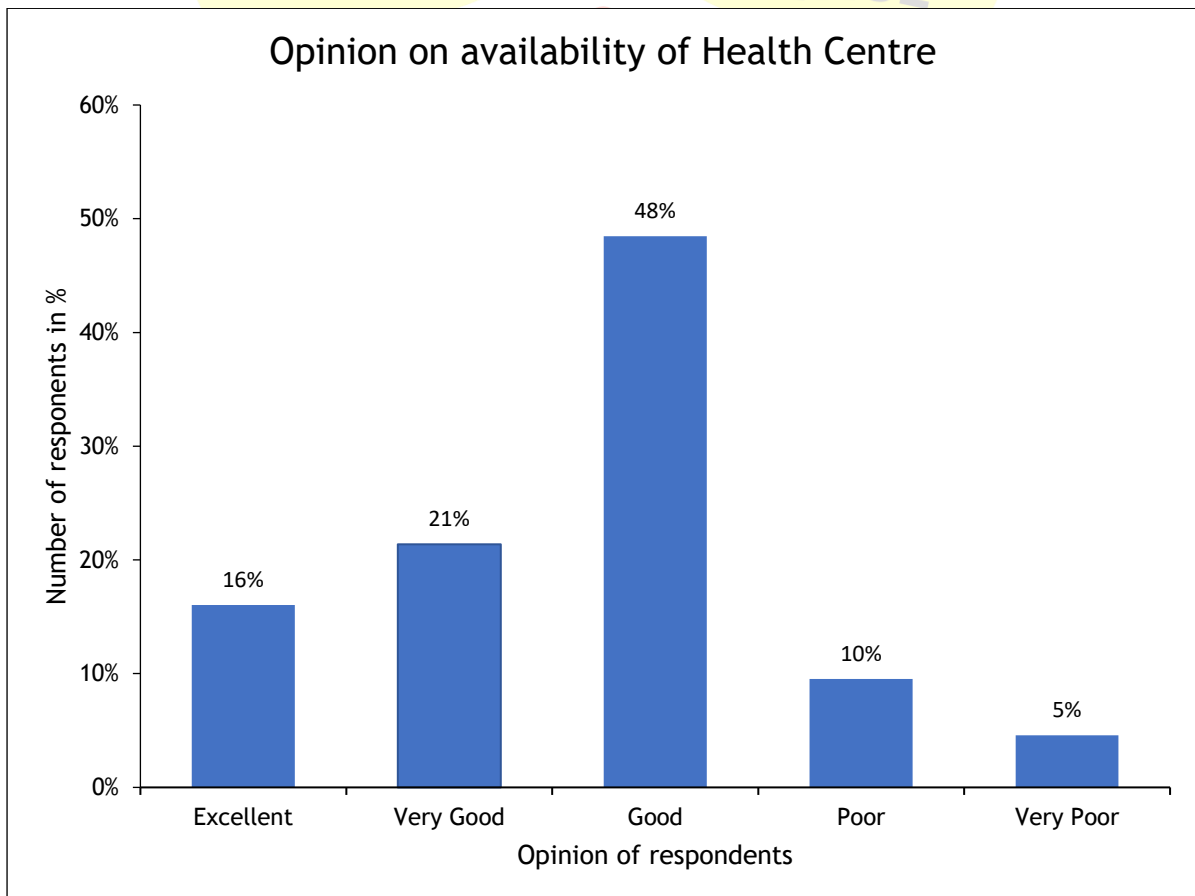


Chart 1: Opinion on availability of Health Centre.

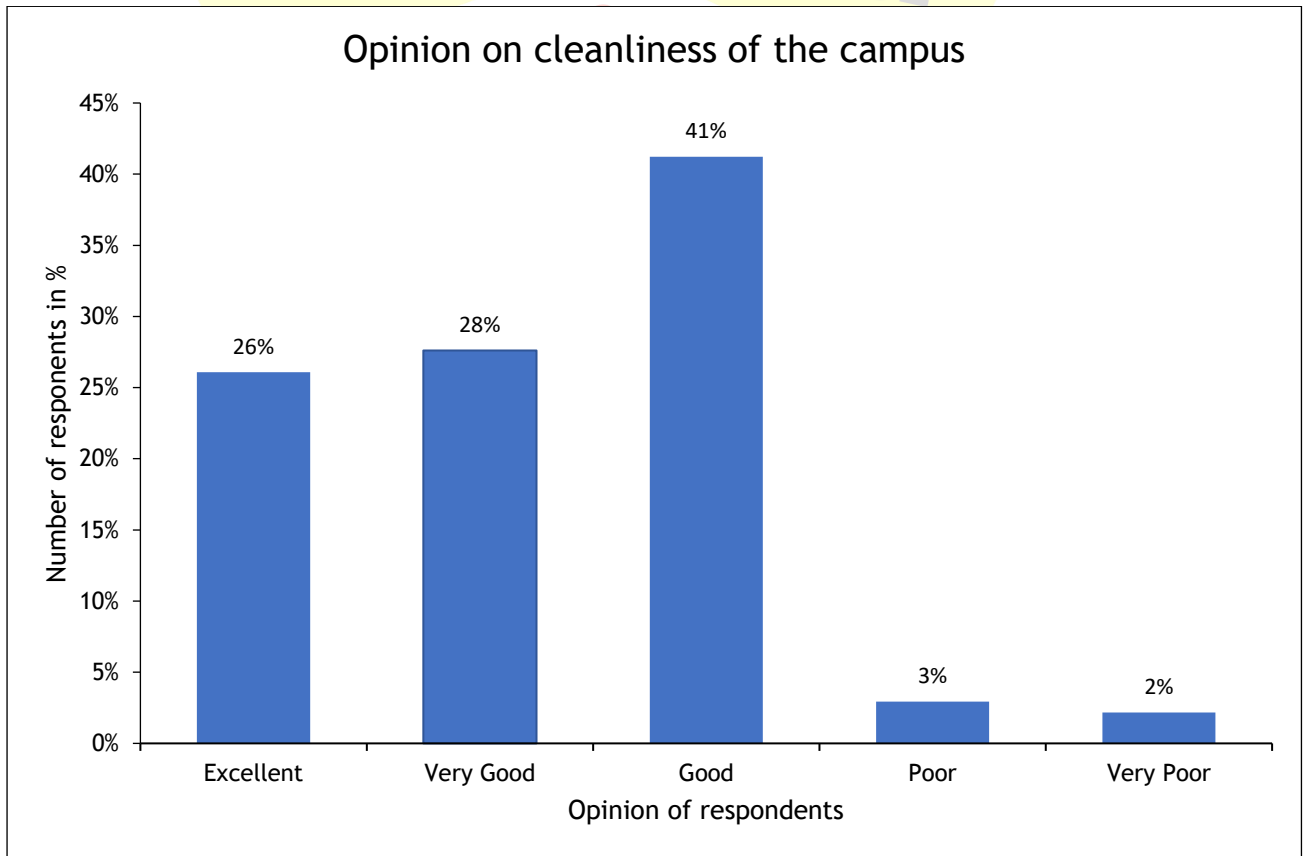


Chart 2: Opinion on cleanliness of the Campus.

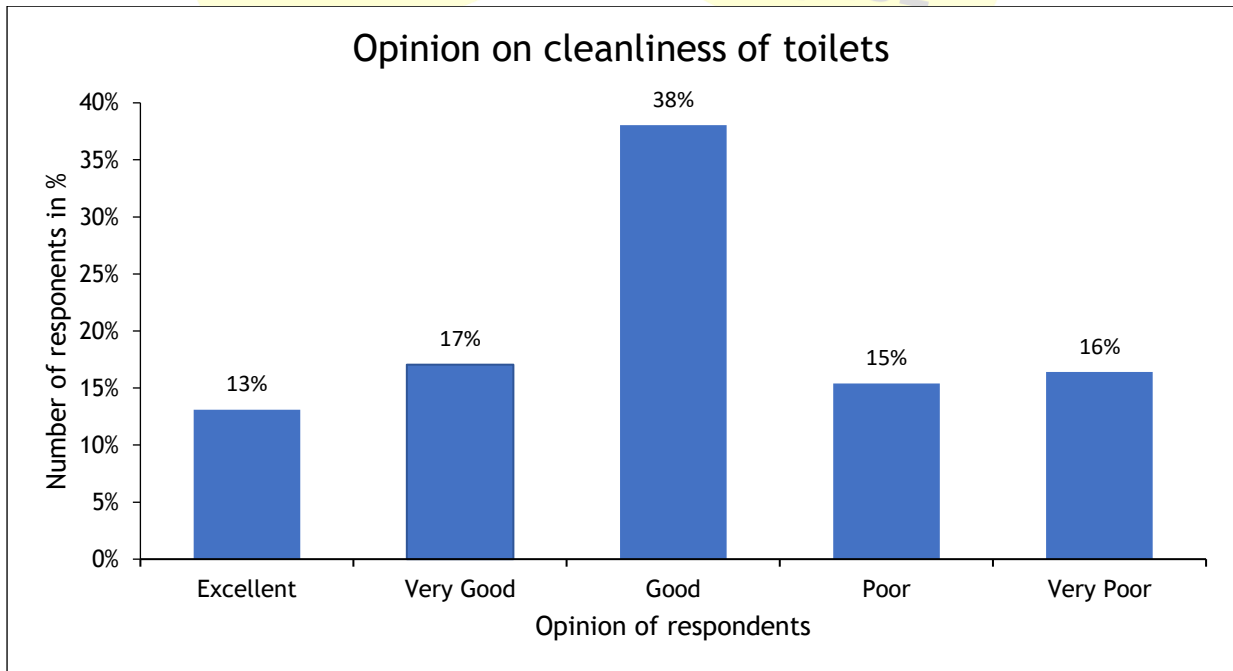


Chart 3: Opinion on the cleanliness of toilets.

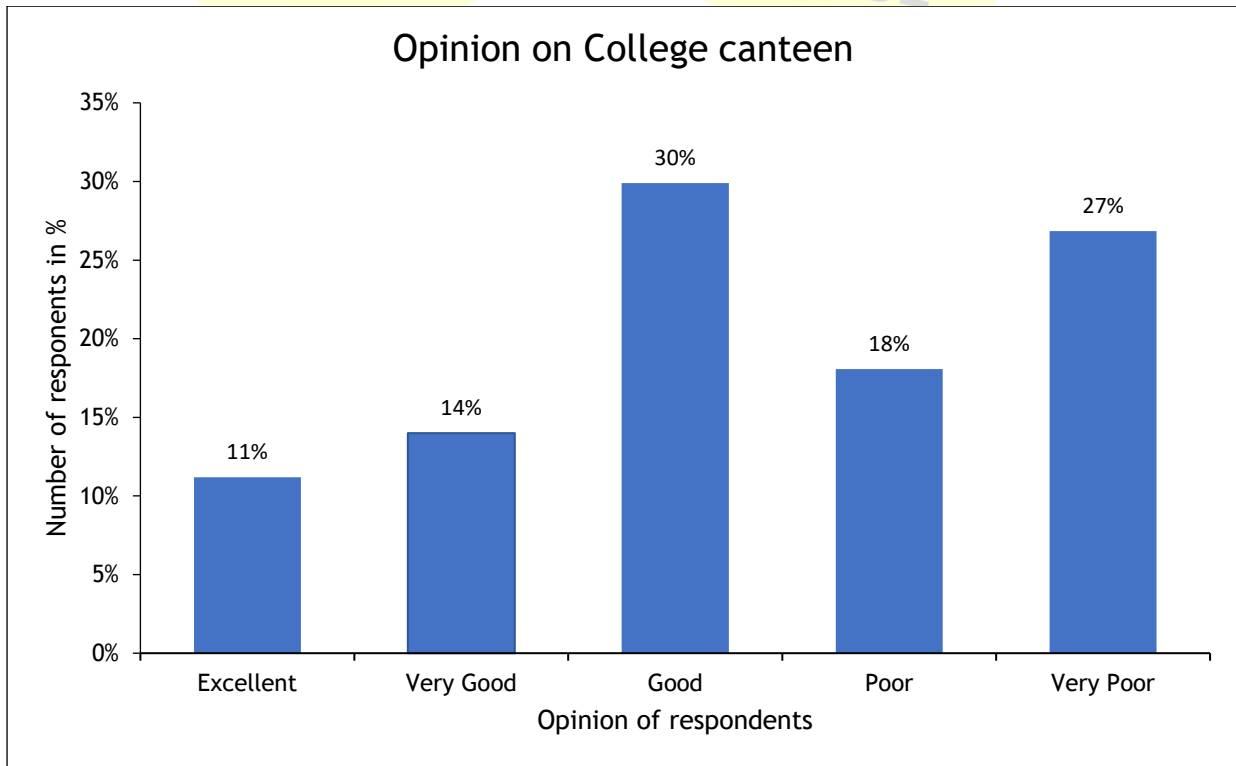


Chart 4: Opinion on College Canteen.

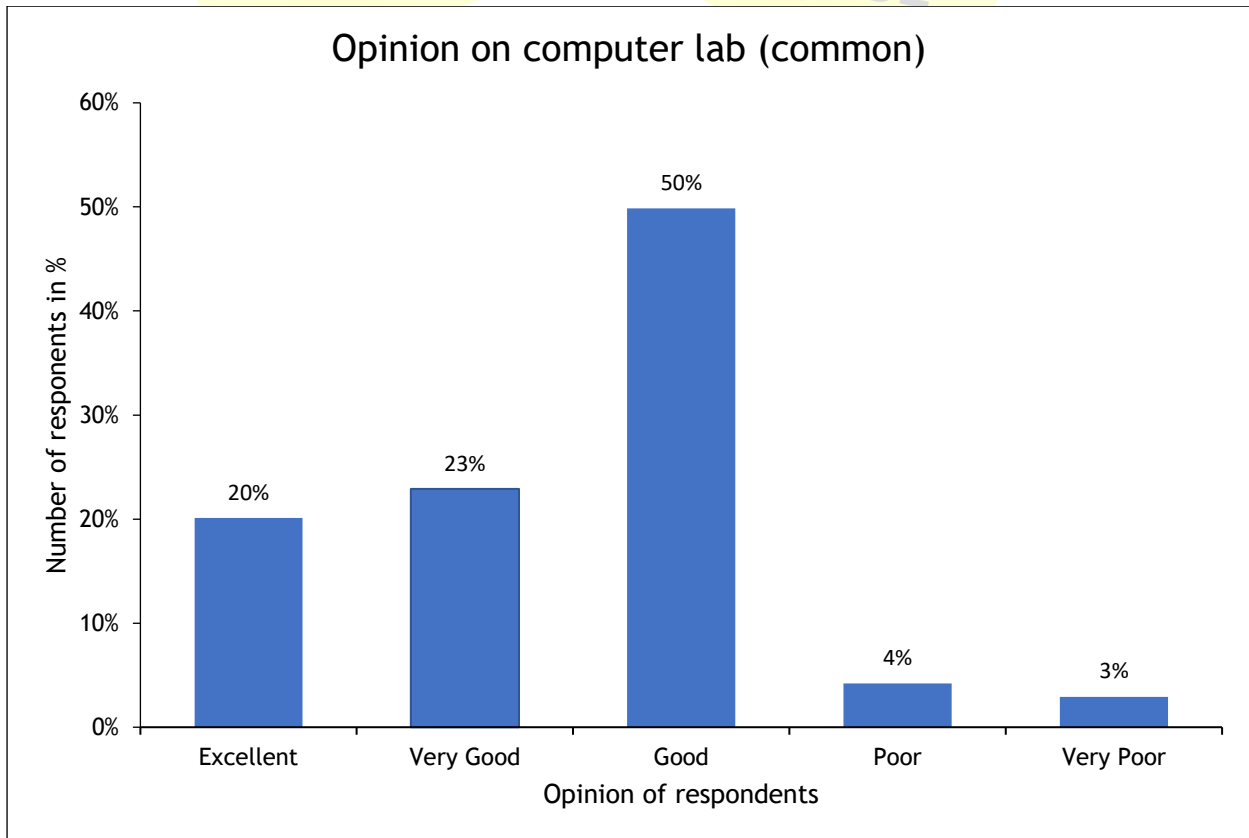


Chart 5: Opinion on Computer lab (common).

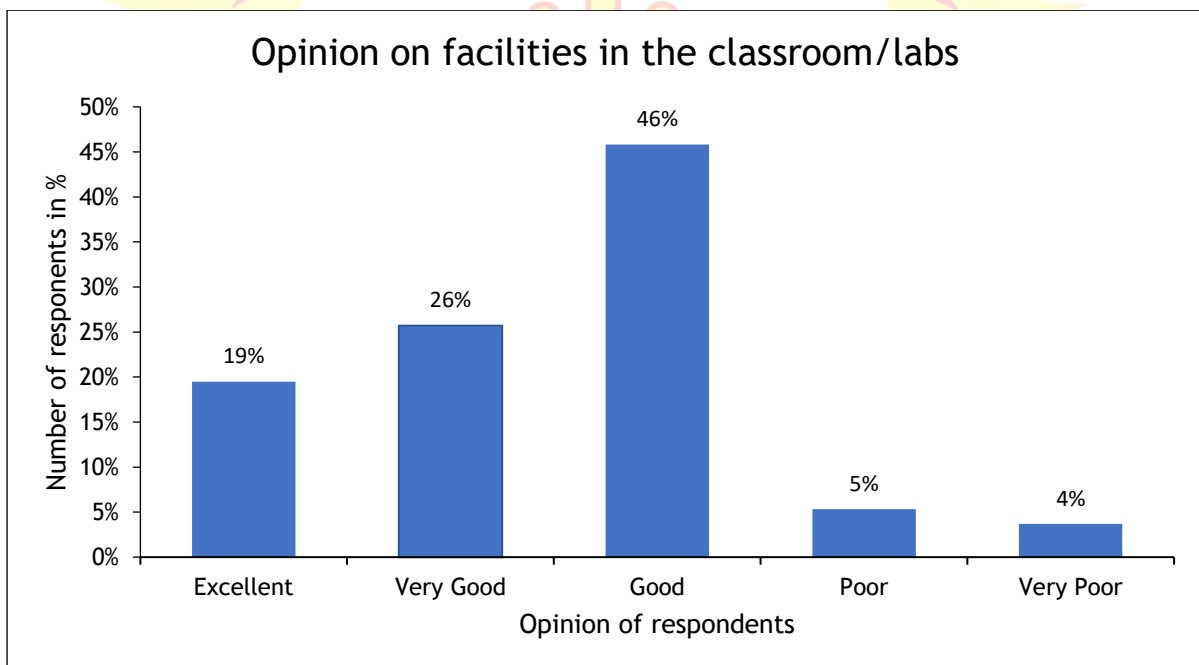


Chart 6: Opinion on facilities in the classroom/labs.

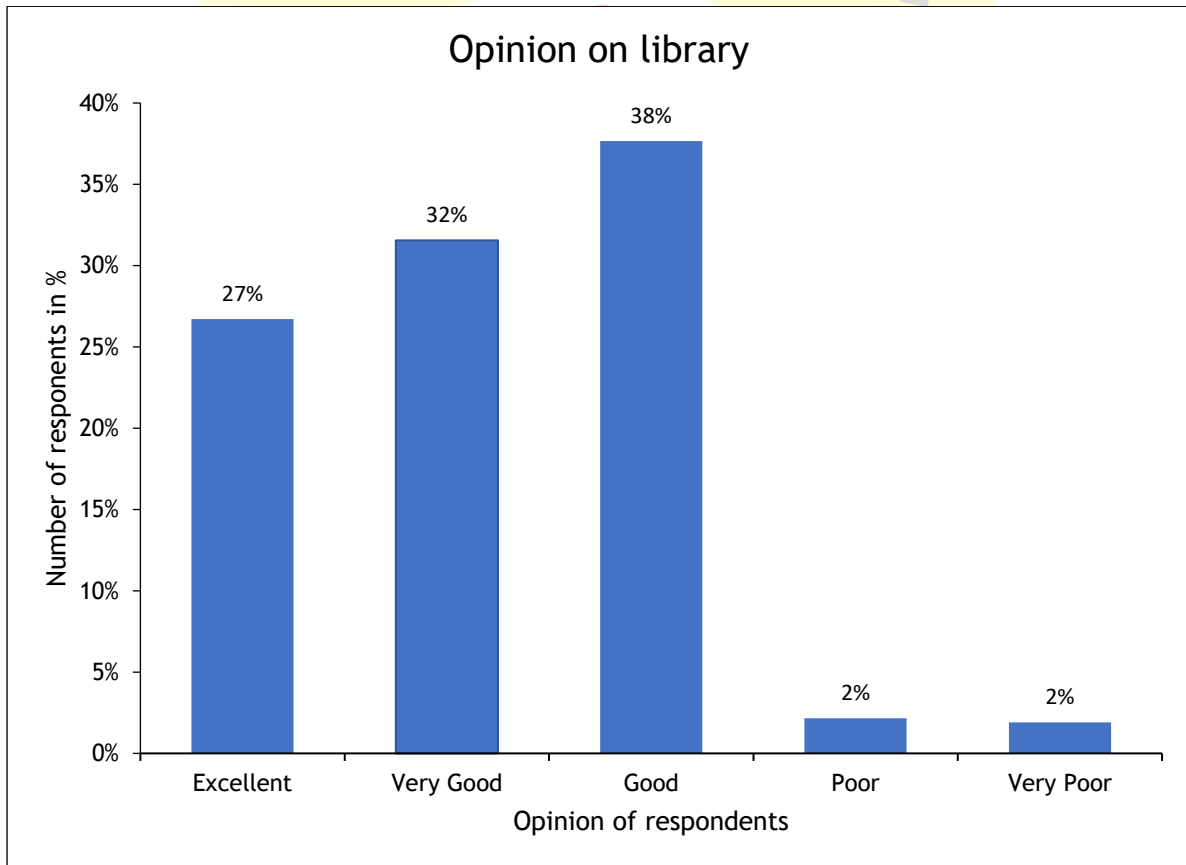


Chart 7: Opinion on the Library.

96% of students are satisfied with the Library, and only a few are not happy.

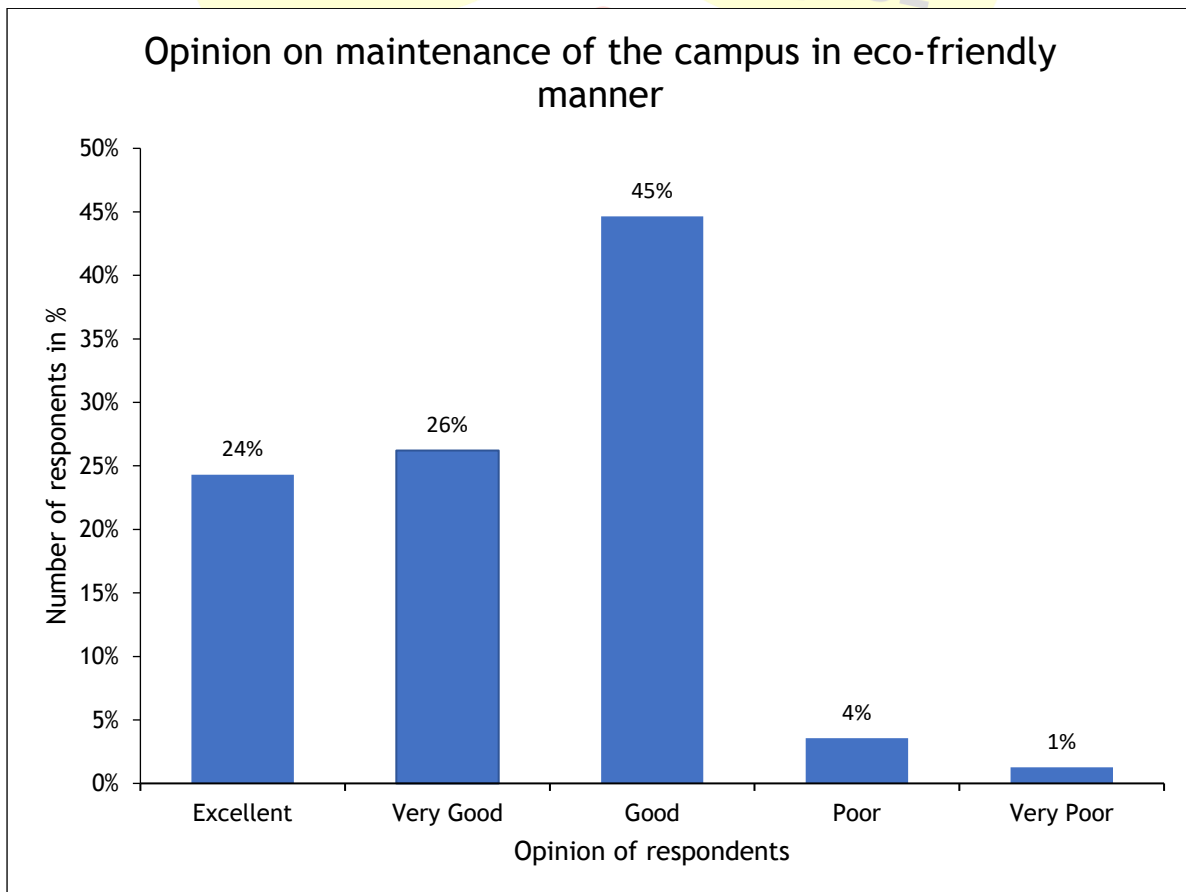

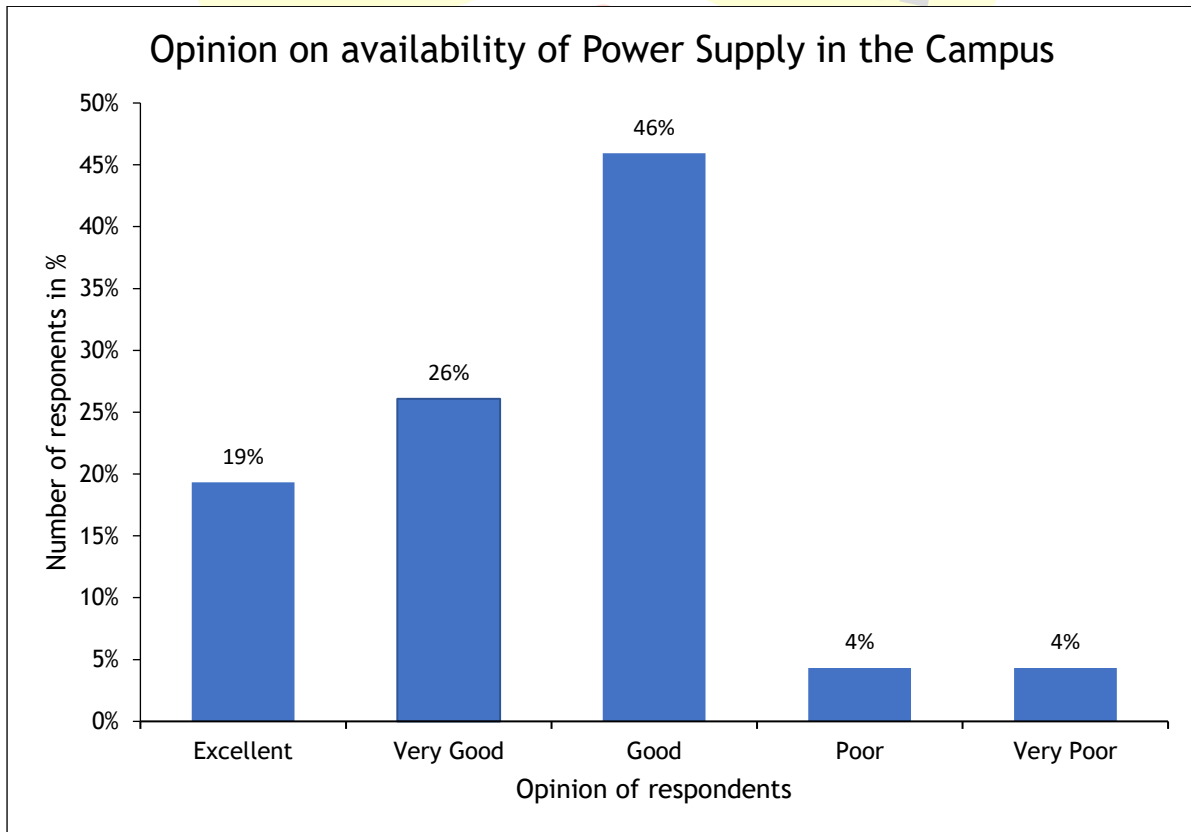


Chart 9: Opinion on parking facility.

92% of students opine that Campus has excellent parking facility, a about 8% students are not satisfied.

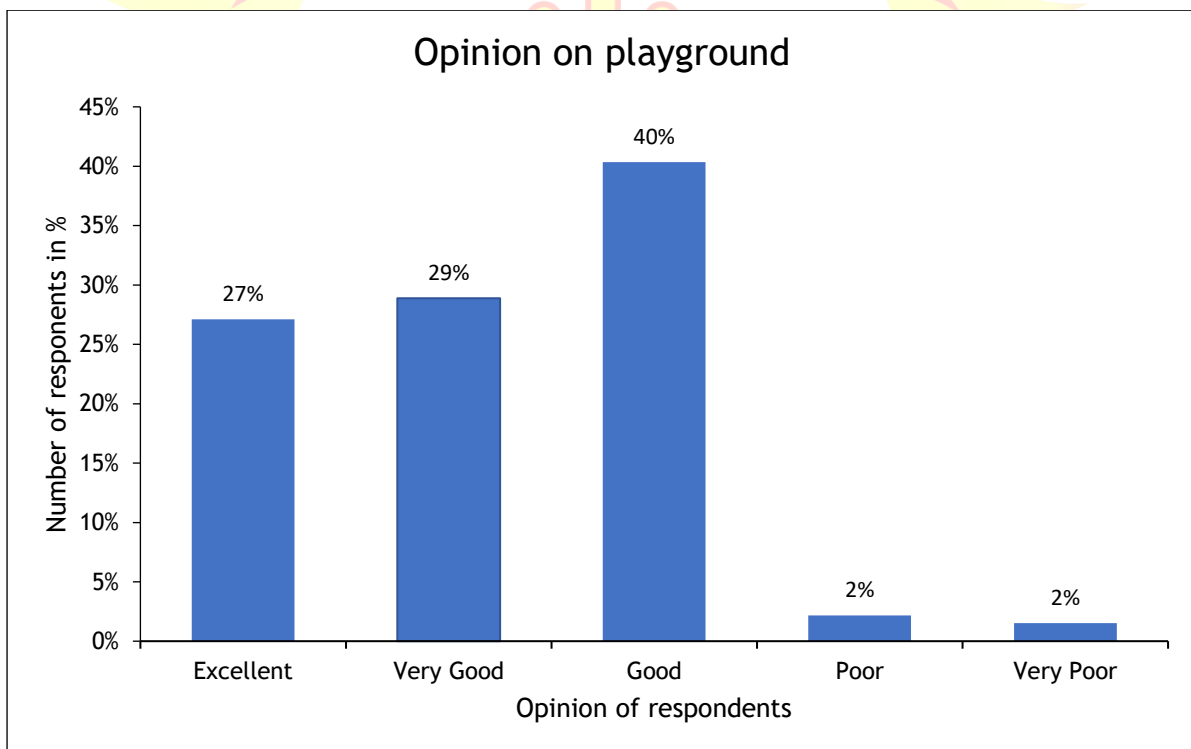

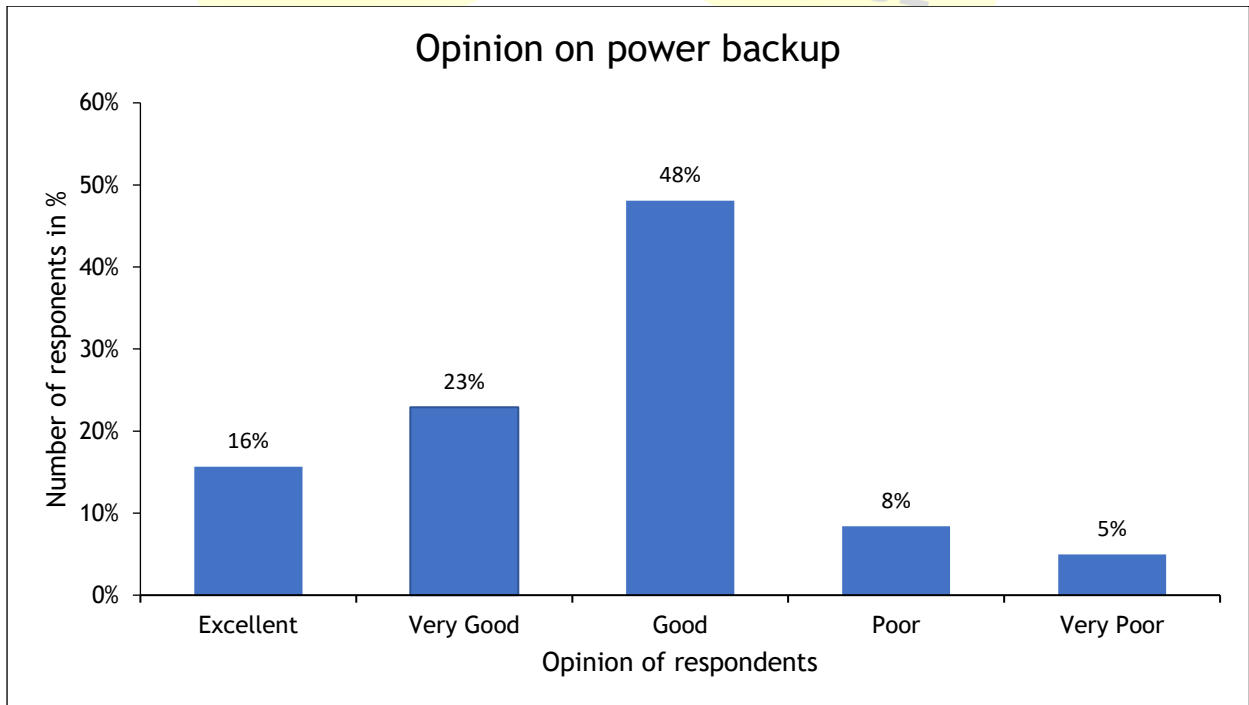


Chart 11: Opinion on power backup.

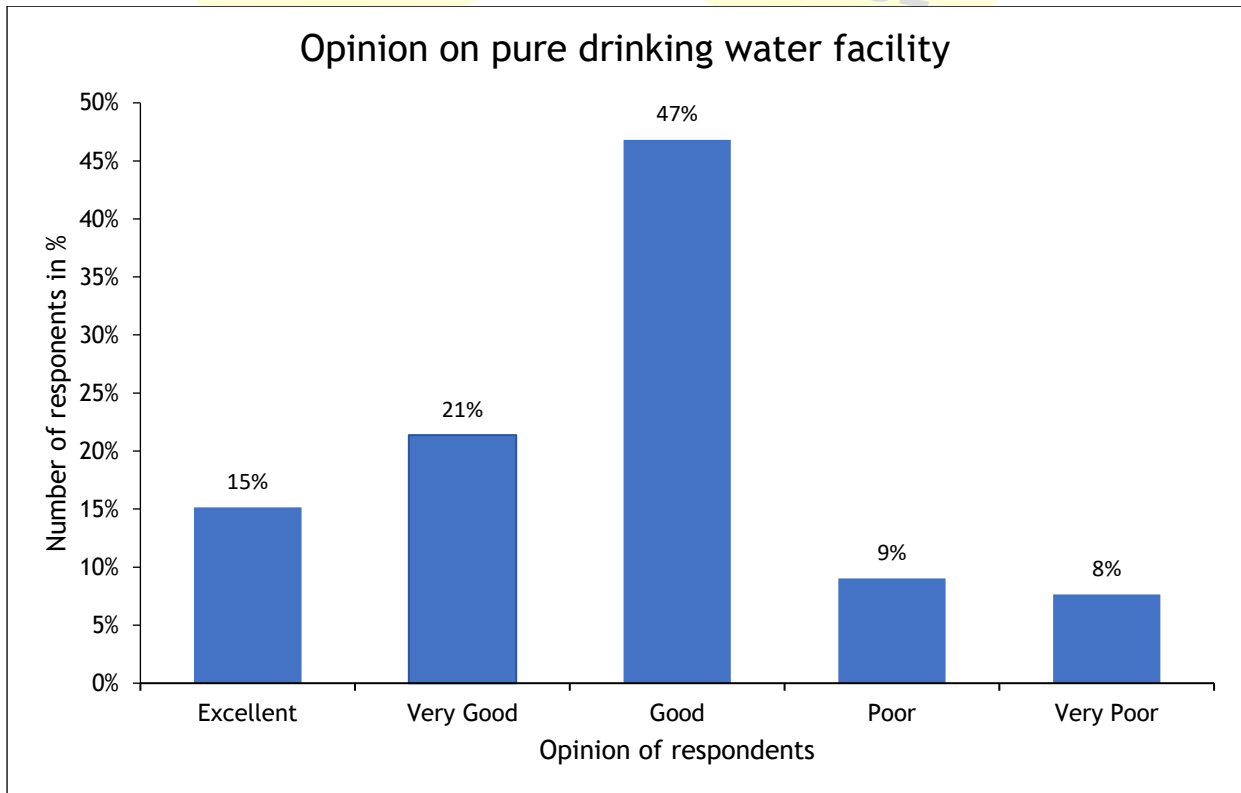


Chart 12: Opinion on pure drinking water facility.

From the response received, it is clear that 83% of students are satisfied with the pure drinking water facility on the Campus, and the remaining percentage of students are not satisfied.

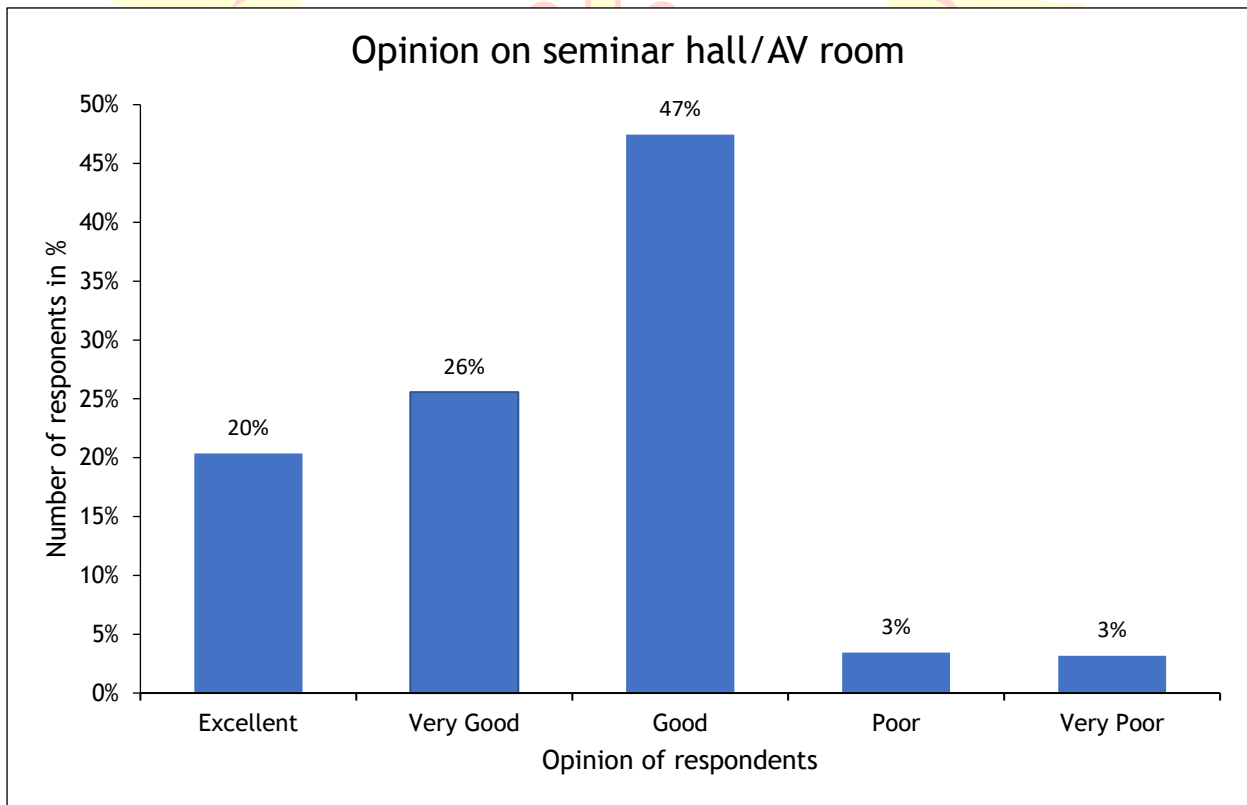

From the bar diagram, it is evident that 94% of the students are happy about the seminar hall/AV room facilities available on the Campus. 6% of students felt it is not adequate.

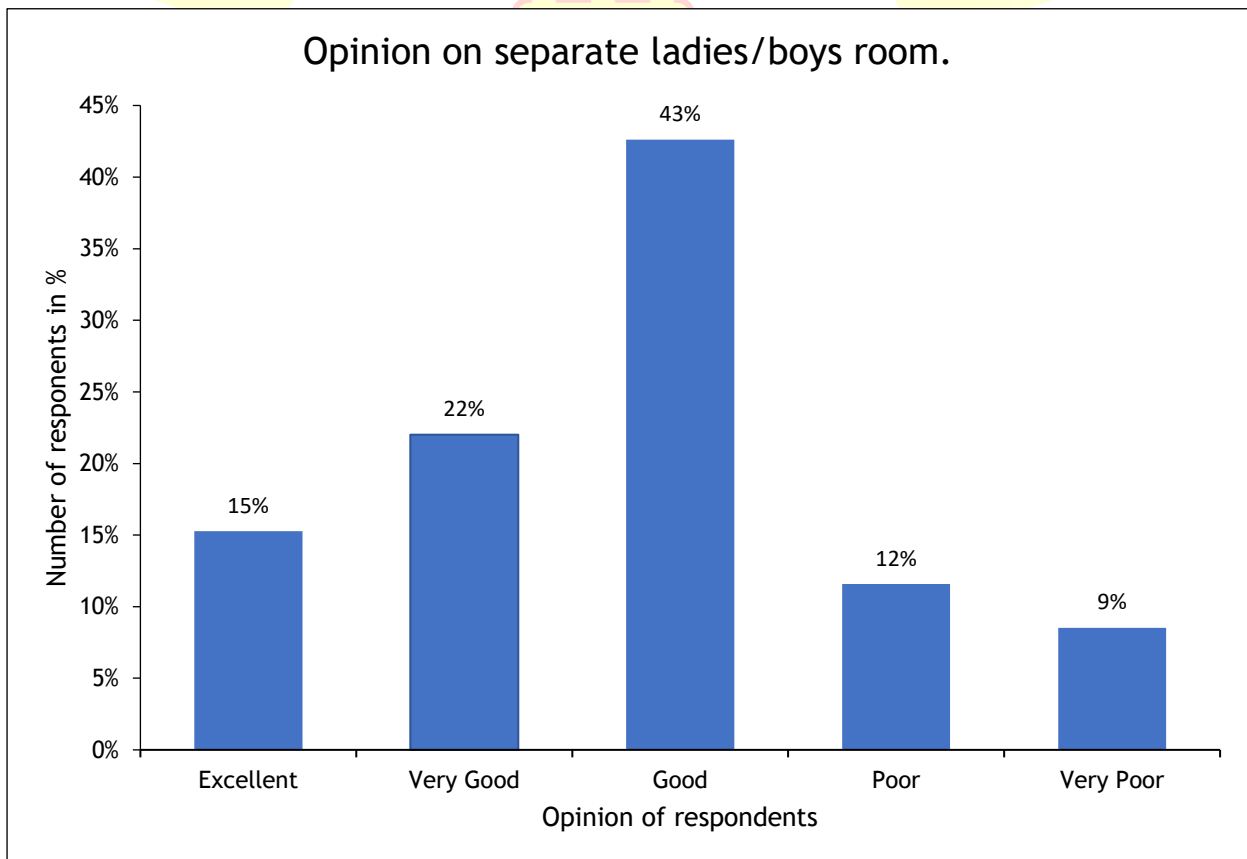

In the bar diagram, it can be observed that 79% of students have satisfaction about separate ladies'/boys rooms, and the rest are not satisfied.

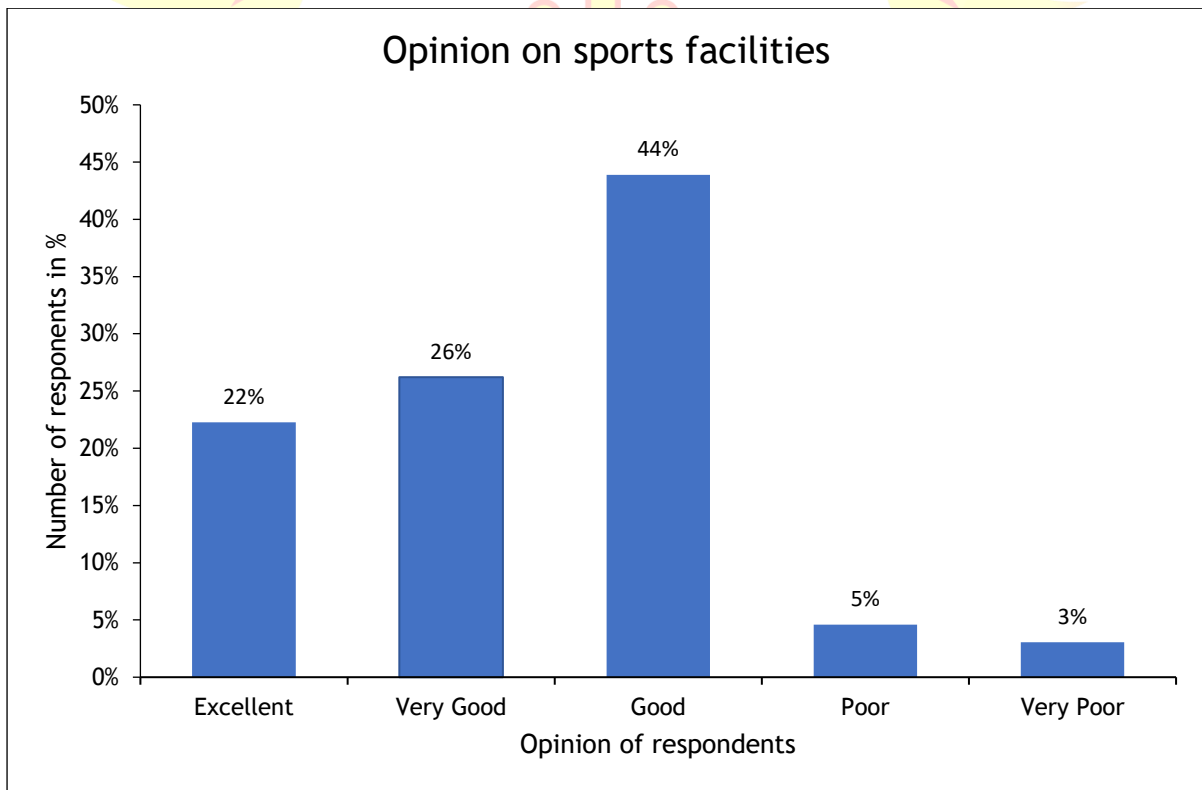

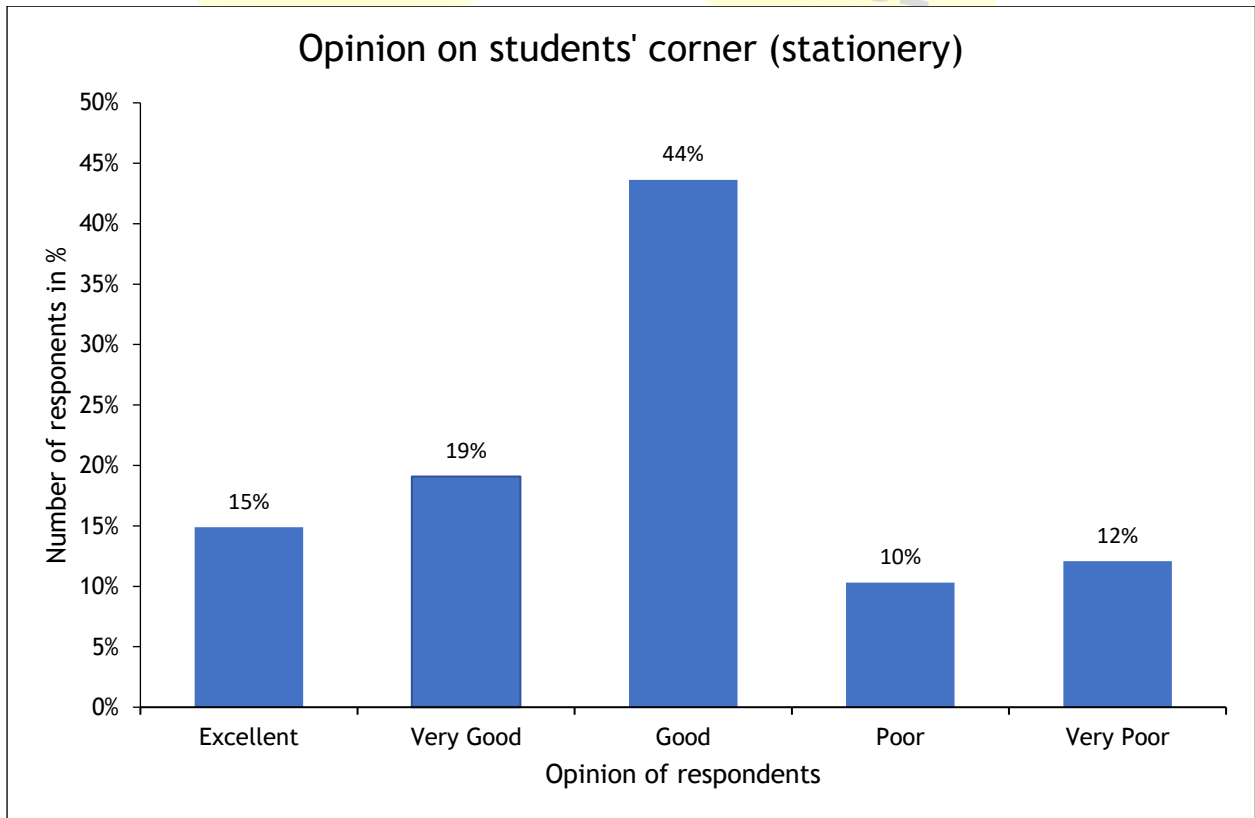


Chart 16: Opinion on students' corner (stationery).

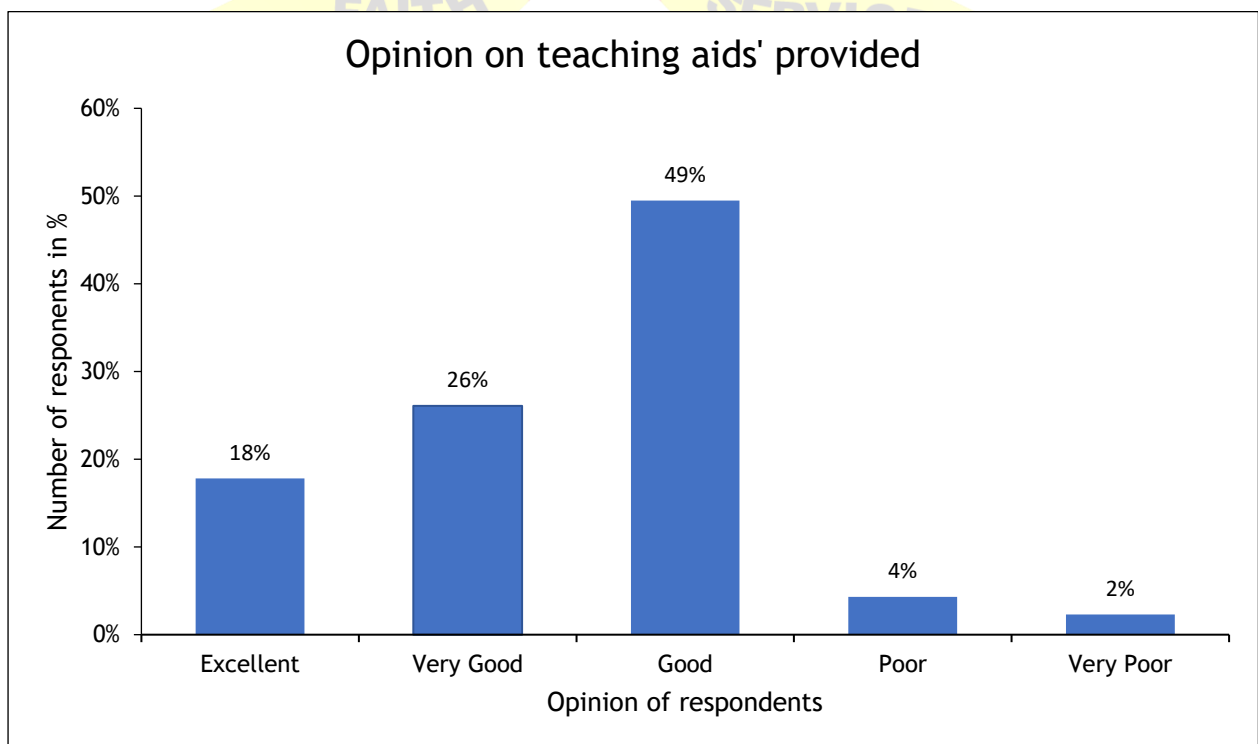


Chart 17: Opinion on teaching aids' provided.

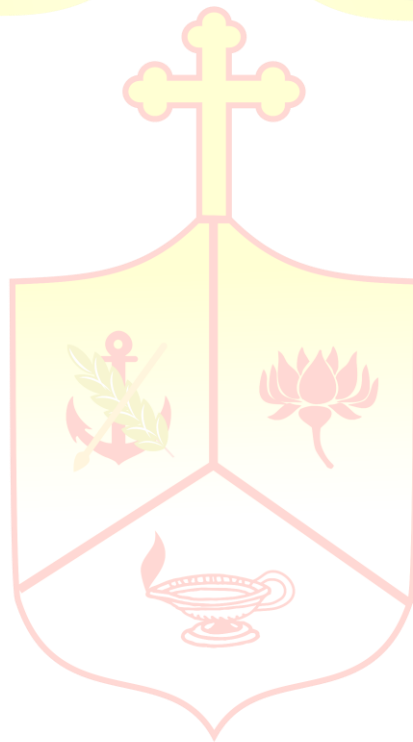
