



It is clear from the above bar diagram that 93% of students are satisfied with the availability of clean drinking water in Campus, and a remaining students are not fully satisfied.



It is clear from the above bar diagram that 95% of students are satisfied with the cleanliness of the College, and a remaining percent of students are not happy.



It is clear from the above bar diagram that 98% of students are satisfied with the cooperation and help by the librarians, and one percent of students are not fully satisfied.







It is clear from the above bar diagram that 93% of students are satisfied with the Internet facility and book facility provided in the library, and 7 percent of students are not fully satisfied












