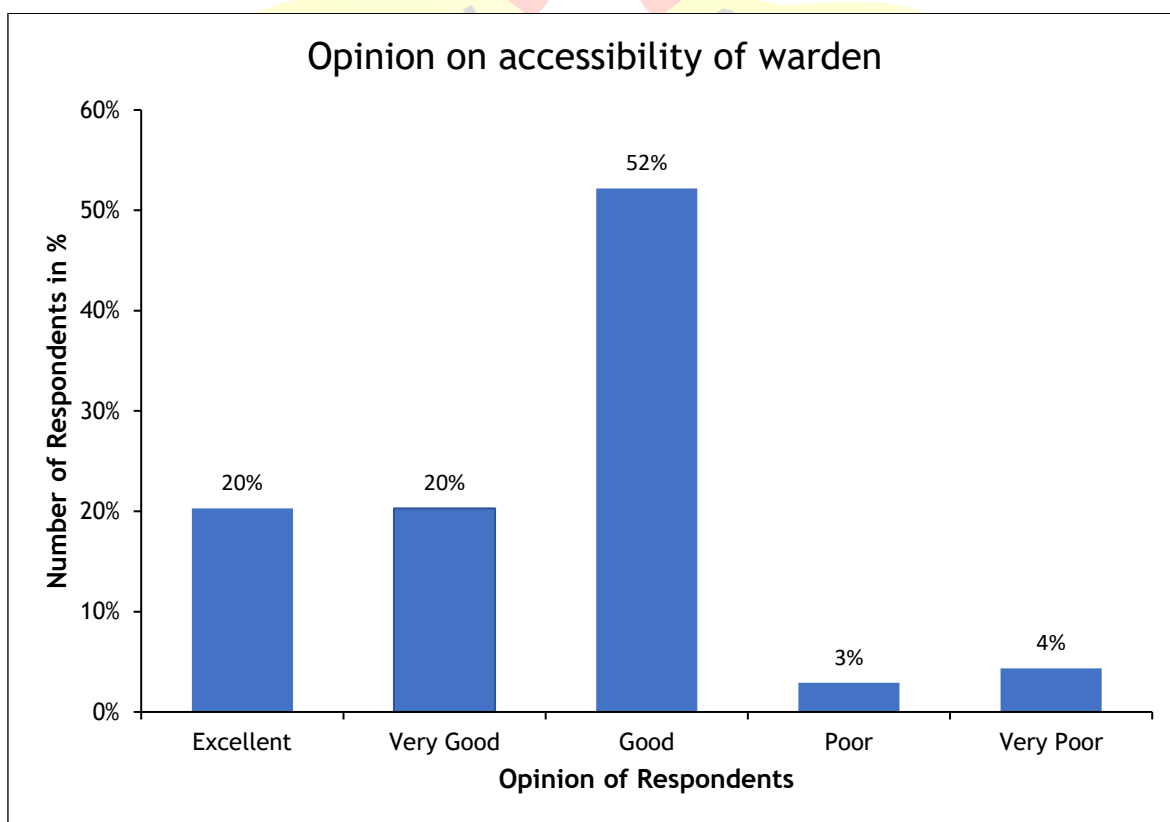

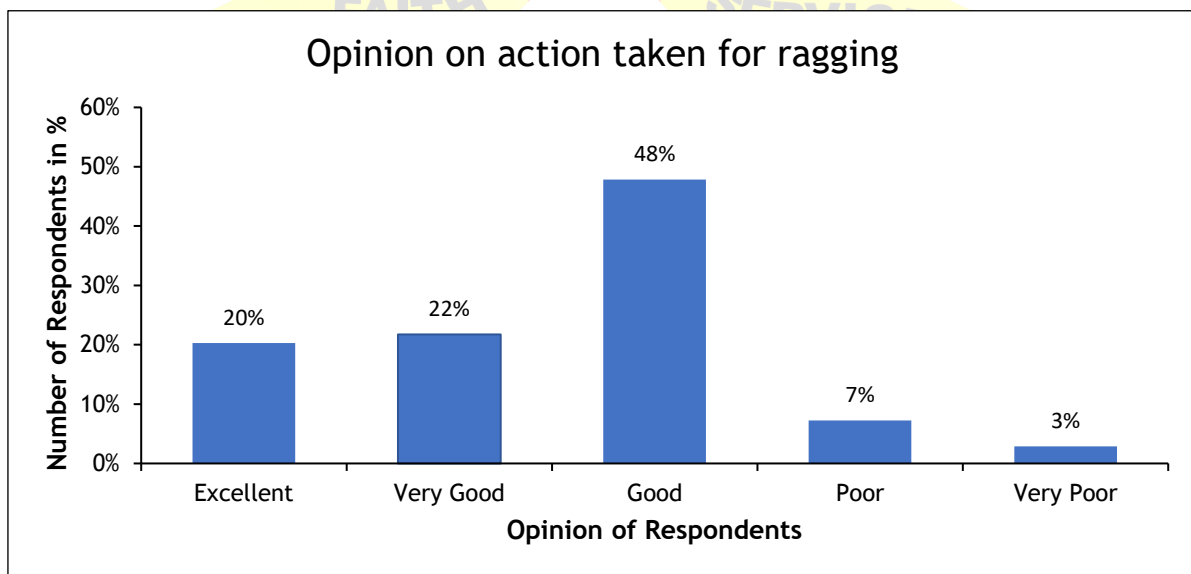
It is clear from the above bar diagram that 93% of students are satisfied with the accessibility of Warden, and the rest of the students are not satisfied.

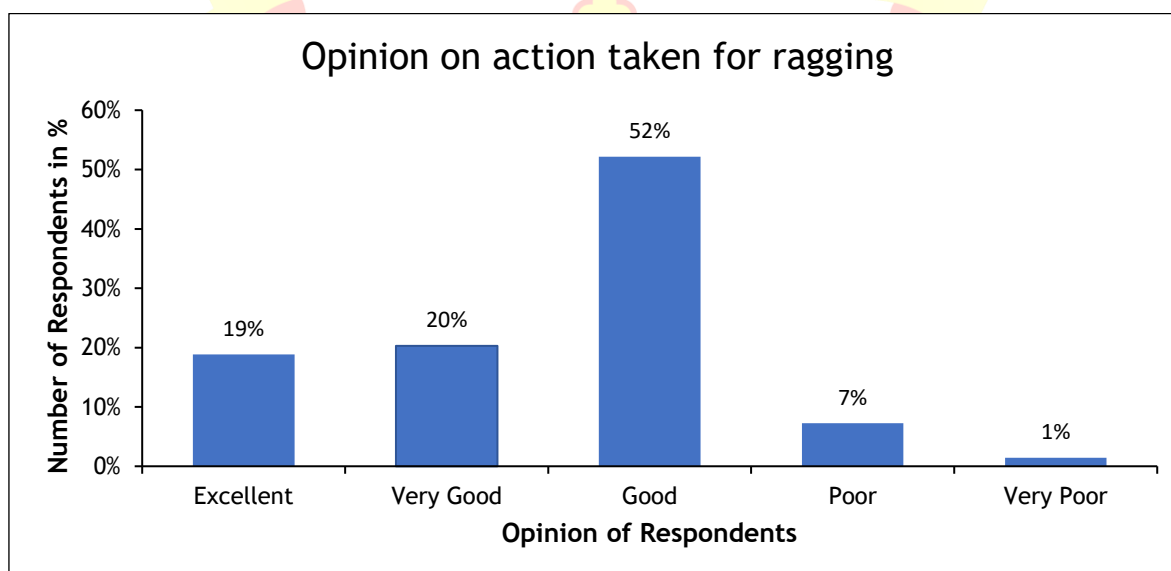
It is clear from the above bar diagram that 90% of students are satisfied with the action taken for ragging, and rest of students are not fully satisfied.

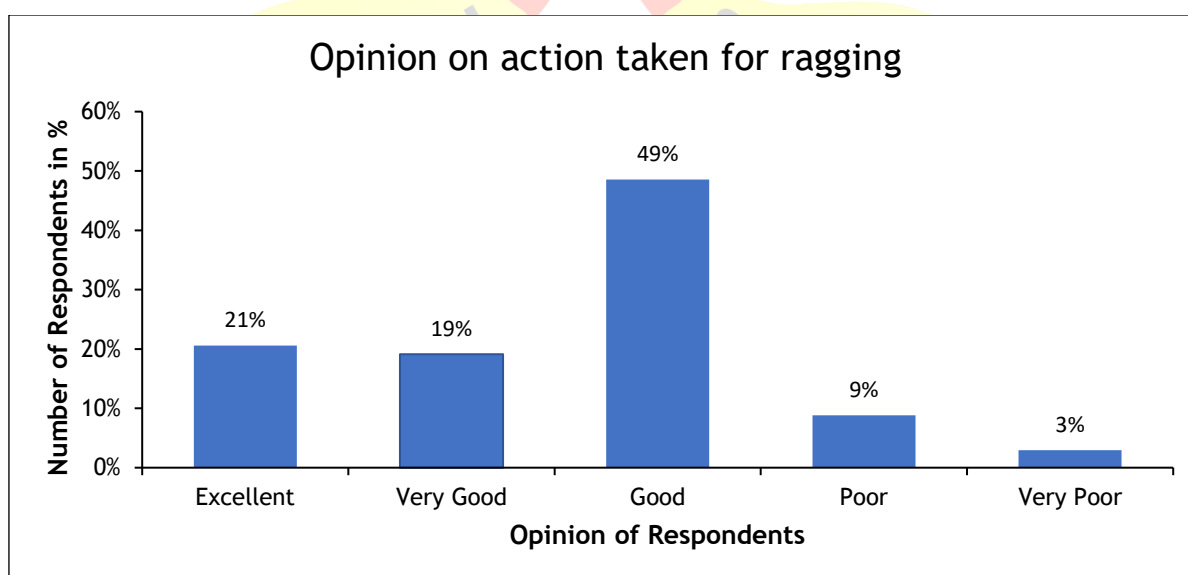
It is clear from the above bar diagram that 92% of students are satisfied with the availability of medical facility, and a few percent of students are not fully satisfied.

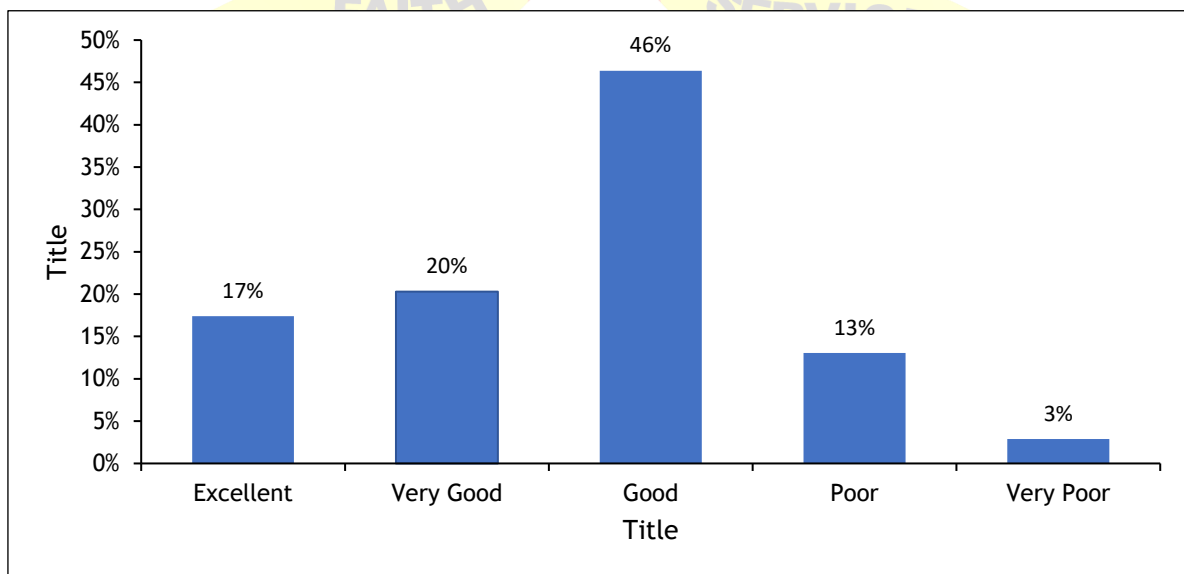
It is clear from the above bar diagram that 88% of students are satisfied with the availability of power and water supply, and a few percent of students are not fully satisfied

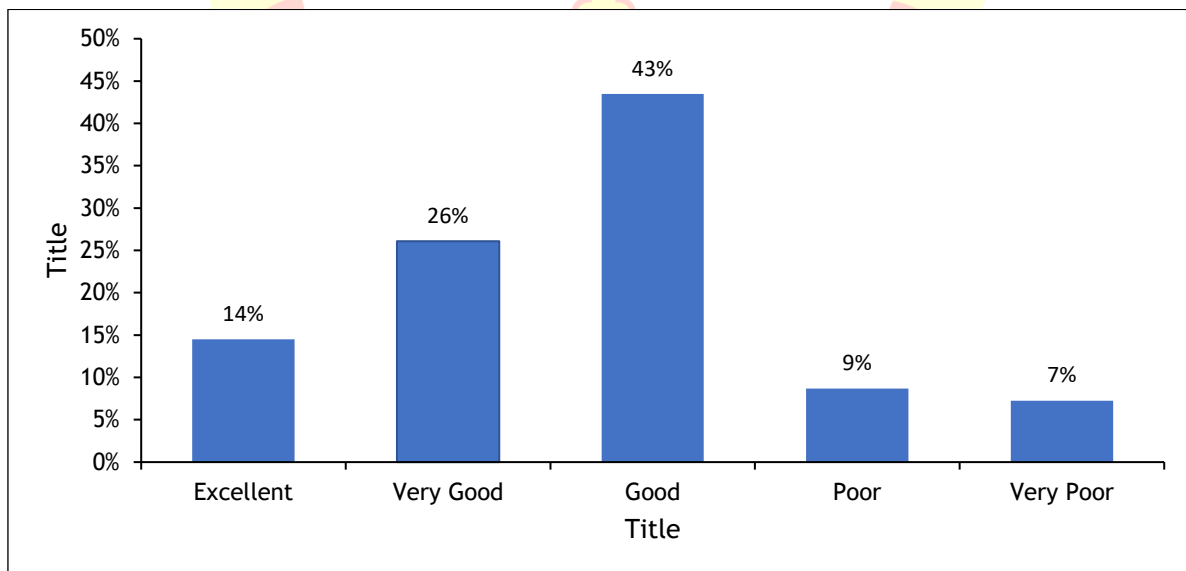

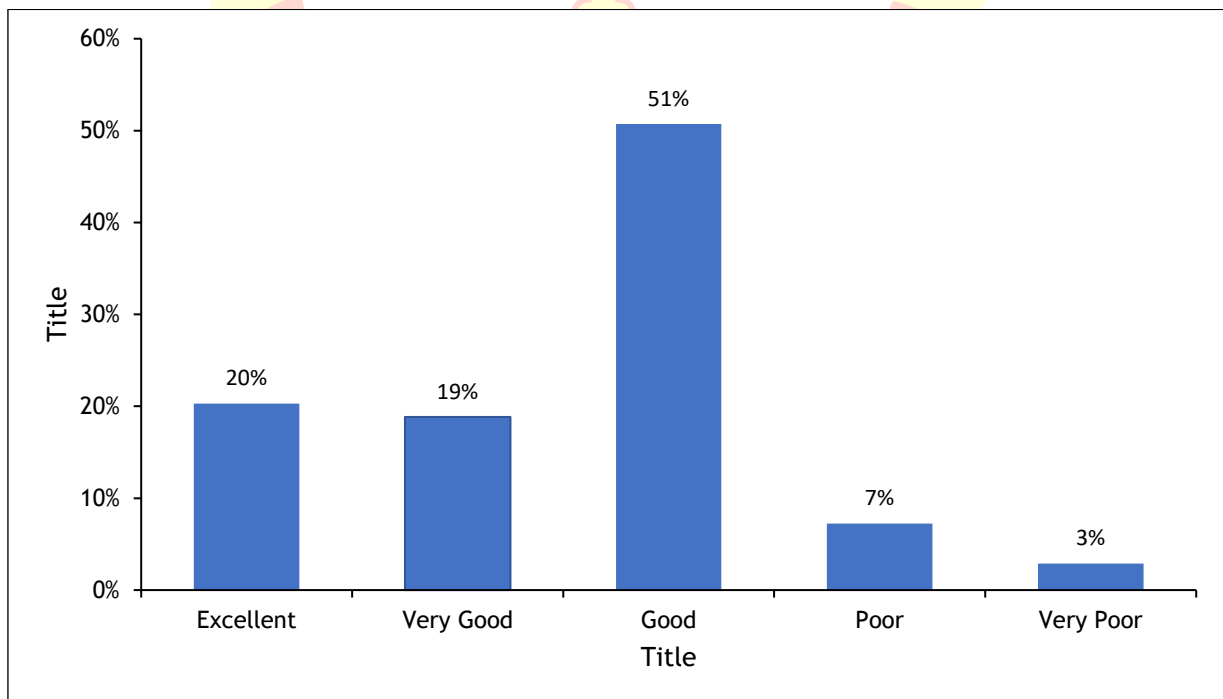

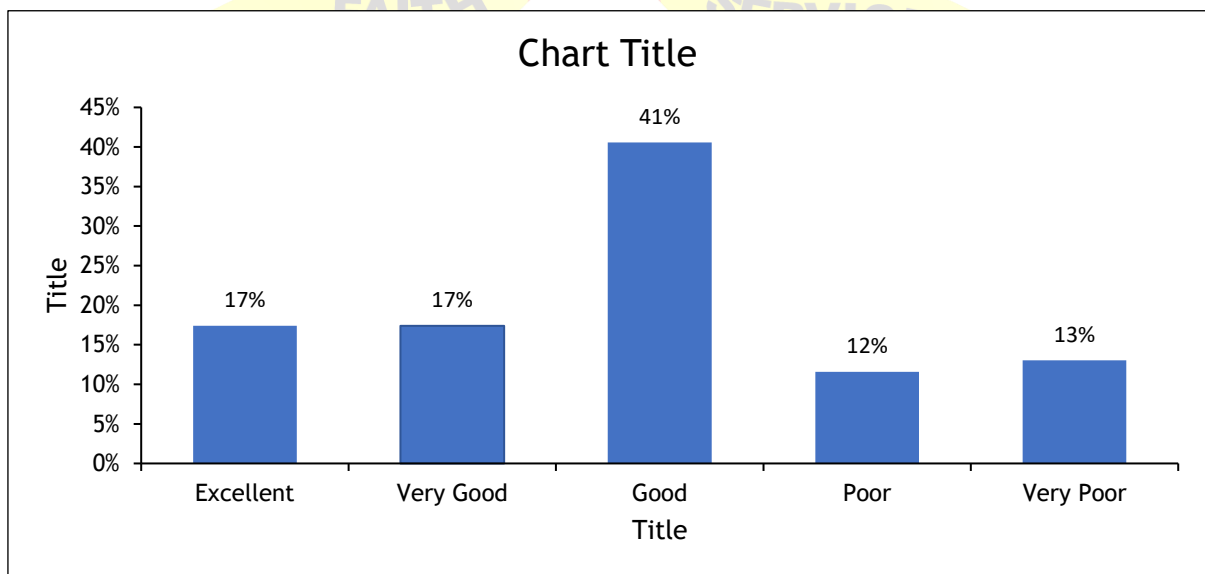

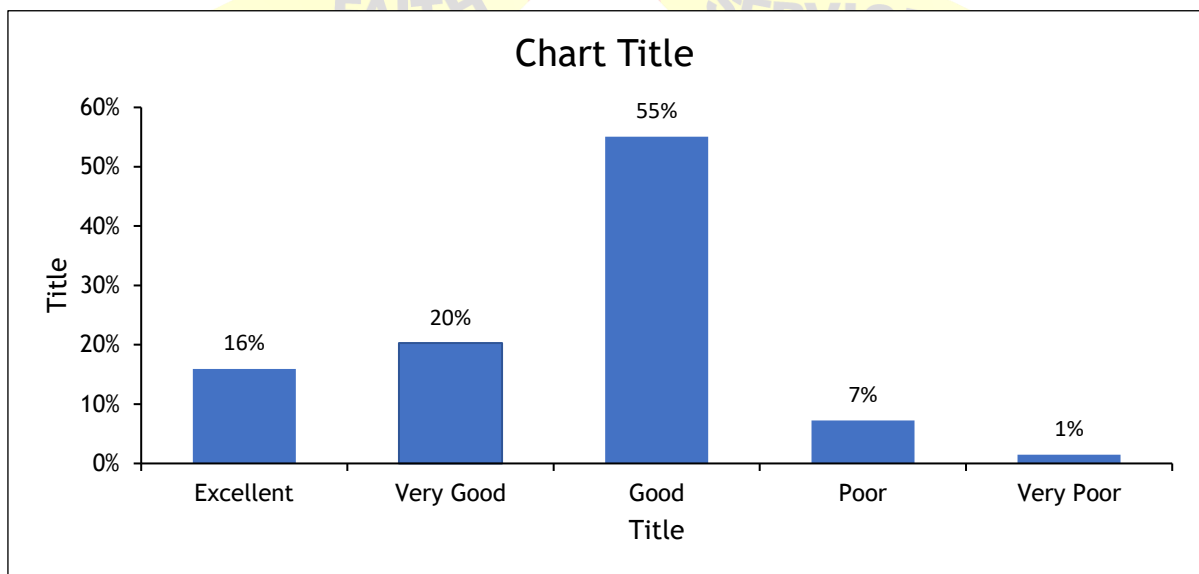

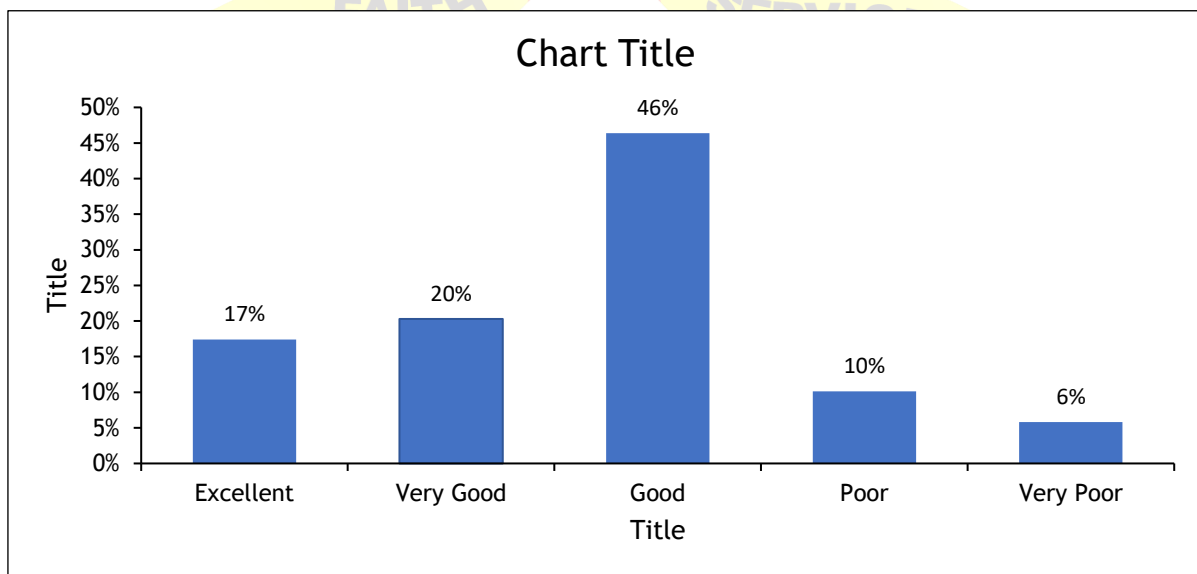
