Q : 1: Opinion on continuity of topics in the syllabus.

Interpretation:

As per the above bar diagram, it is obvious that majority of the students have no complaints regarding the continuity of topics in syllabus, but just 2% of students expressed their displeasure about the continuity of topics in the syllabus

Q : 2: Opinion on flexibility of curriculum.

Interpretation:

As depicted in the above bar diagram, 99% of the students have no complaints regarding the flexibility of curriculum, but 1% of students express their unhappiness about the flexibility of the curriculum.

Q : 3: Opinion on Motivation for higher studies and research.

Interpretation:

From the above bar diagram, it is evident that most of the students gets enough motivation for higher studies and research at our college, but few students opinion is that motivation for higher studies and research is not sufficient.

Q : 4: Opinion on Relevance and depth of syllabus.

Interpretation:

From the above bar diagram, it is evident that good number of the students express the satisfactory response regarding relevance and depth of syllabus. That is 98& 2%

Q : 5: Opinion on scope for job opportunities.

Interpretation:

According to the bar diagram above, good number of students think that the scope for job opportunities is satisfactory and very few students say that it is to be improved. i.e. 97&3%

Q : 6: Opinion on set up of the syllabus for different semesters.

Interpretation:

As can be seen from the above bar diagram, good number of students have excellent opinion on set up of the syllabus for different semesters. In addition, 2% of the pupils opine that set up of the syllabus for different semesters is not satisfactory.

Q : 7: Opinion on to what extent the curriculum is skill oriented.
