St Philomena College, Puttur, was established in 1958. At that time, there was no institution of higher education in this part of rural coastal Karnataka. People had to go to either Mangalore or Madikeri. The region badly needed a College. The visionary Catholic priest Msgr Antony Patrao, established St Philomena College to provide education for all without social and religious discrimination. Over the years, the College has expanded in tune with the changing times to become one of the premier higher education affiliated with Mangalore University.

Management

The College is managed by The Catholic Board of Education, Mangaluru, the top Management. Most Rev. Dr. Peter Paul Saldanha, Bishop, Diocese of Mangaluru, is the President, Msgr Maxim L. Noronha the Vice President and Very Rev. Fr Antony Shera is the Secretary. The local Management Committee is headed by Very Rev. Fr Lawrence Mascarenhas, Parish Priest, Mai De Deus Church, Puttur as Joint Secretary.

1. Staff

The College has 67 teaching staff members in the UG section and 32 in the PG section. The Office Staff consists of 24 members in the UG section and 5 in the PG section

2. Students

The College on its roll has **1581** students in the UG section of whom **745** are boys and **836** are girls. In the PG section there are **305** students of whom **47** are boys and **258** are girls.

3. Programs offered:

The College offers 6 U.G. programmes – BA, B.Com, B.Sc., BBA, BCA and BSW and 6 P.G. programmes–MSW, M.Com, M.Sc.-Physics, M.Sc.-Mathematics, M.Sc.-Computer Science and M.A. Economics.
