Management

The College is managed by The Catholic Board of Education, Mangaluru, the top Management. Most Rev. Dr. Peter Paul Saldanha, Bishop, Diocese of Mangaluru, is the President, Msgr Maxim L. Noronha the Vice President and Very Rev. Fr Antony Shera is the Secretary. The local Management Committee is headed by Very Rev. 1. Staff
