

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is entered into on this day 11th January, 2018

BETWEEN

GOVERNMENT FIRST GRADE COLLEGE VITTAL, BANTWAL TALUK, D.K.
(Hereinafter referred to as GFGCVTL)

AND

ST PHILOMENA COLLEGE, PUTTUR, D.K.
(Hereinafter referred to as SPC)

represented by the Principals of respective institutions recognizing the mutual academic benefits to their institutions through the agreement for collaborative partnership.

GFGCVTL and SPC hereinafter referred to individually as "Party" and collectively as "Parties" as per the context.

Recitals:

- A. Government First Grade College Vittal**, affiliated to Mangalore University situated in a sprawling campus of 6.9 acres came into existence in 1993 in order to provide higher education to the rural youth of Vittal. In 2002, it acquired its own building and at present it provides education in arts, commerce and social work with a vision to provide academic, professional and physical education for students of all sections of the society with a special emphasis to poor and weaker sections, aiming at achieving excellence in quality and output. It is also recognized under section 2f and 12B of the UGC Act. In addition to formal education the institution provides ample opportunities to the students to develop leadership qualities, participate in extracurricular activities to bring out their latent talents.
- B. St Philomena College** was founded by Msgr Antony Patrao in the year 1958. Since its inception, the College has been growing steadily. The quantitative growth has been supplemented by undiluted quality. The College has been imparting higher education to the youth drawn from far and wide. Students are enrolled without discrimination. Msgr Patrao tended the Institution with motherly care. His example was emulated by his successors. Resultantly the College has earned a name by virtue of its disciplined functioning and its achievements in the academic field as well as in the field of sports and games. Based on its infrastructure, learning resources and achievements, the College has been re-accredited by NAAC at "A" Grade.



- C. The objective of this agreement is to explore the areas of mutual cooperation so as to serve student community better by placing at the disposal of it whatever expertise is available with both the parties.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH as follows:

1. AREAS OF COOPERATION/ COLLABORATION:

- a. Exchange of the faculty members as Resource Persons that facilitate enriched learning
- b. Mutual exchange of students for the participation in the activities such as seminars, workshops, competitions which would facilitate the students in augmenting their competence.
- c. Collaboratively conducting student-centric activities/ programmes such as seminars, workshops, and study camps, outreach activities etc.
- d. Exchange of academic information and materials for the purpose of academic advancement
- e. Promoting essential academic co-operation as mutually agreed upon

2. CONFIDENTIALITY:

Each party shall maintain complete confidentiality of any information of other, disclosed during the term of this Agreement (Confidential Information), either directly or indirectly in any form whatsoever including, but not limited to, in writing, in machine readable or other tangible form, orally or visually (subsequently reduced to writing). Both parties undertake to (i) hold all such confidential information in strictest confidence, (ii) not to disclose such confidential information either in whole or in part to any person other than those of its officers, employees and agents who need to know the officer, employee or agent has agreed in writing to maintain the confidentiality of the confidential information in accordance with the terms hereof or (iii) not to use such confidential information for any purpose, whatsoever, save as may be strictly necessary for the performance of this agreement.

3. DURATION OF MOU AND AMENDMENTS:

The MOU shall be in force for a period of FIVE years commencing from the date of signing and may be further reviewed by mutual consent. This agreement may not be amended without the prior written consent of both the parties.

4. TERMINATION OF MOU:

Either party can cancel or terminate this agreement unilaterally (and without reason) by giving an advance written notice of 30 days.



5. NOTICES:

All notices, requests, demand and other communications under this agreement or in connection herewith shall be given to or made upon the respective parties as follows:
