

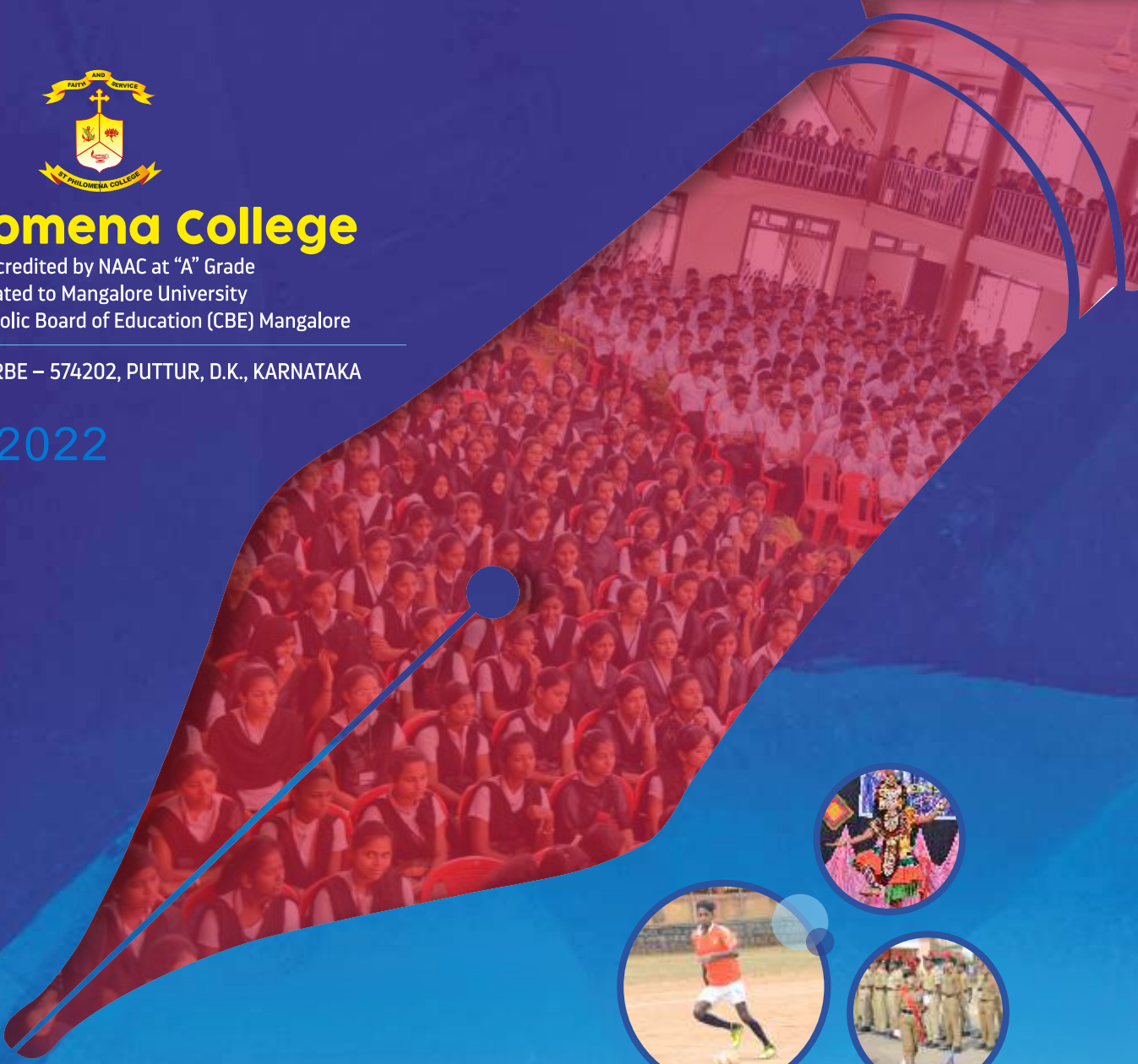

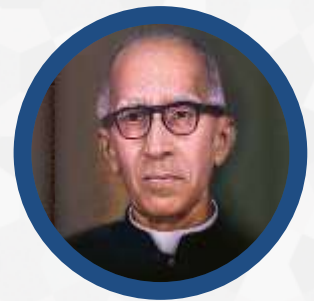

## COURSES OFFERED

The College offers SIX UG Degree Programmes under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) of Mangalore University. A three year degree programme comprises SIX Semesters of 16 weeks each. At the end of each Semester the University conducts Semester Examinations. Class, distinction, etc. are declared semester-wise. Ranks and Alpha Grades are announced on the basis of the performance of students in all the six semesters put together.

# Admission Procedure

- ◆ Application for admission must be made in the prescribed form available with this booklet.
- ◆ Provisional marks of the qualifying examinations can be entered in the application form
- ◆ Students belonging to SC/ST category should attach appropriate certificate issued by the competent authority
- ◆ Applicants will be intimated over the phone about their provisional selection and schedule for an interview within 10 days from the last date for registration.
- ◆ During the interview, the applicant should produce the following certificates/ documents.
- ◆ Transfer Certificate (TC) from the institution last attended t Marks card of the qualifying examination
- ◆ Conduct Certificate
- ◆ Three Passport size color photos t Photocopy of the Ration Card or Aadhar Card of the student and parents
- ◆ Document in proof of reservation/ concession claimed
- ◆ Migration/eligibility certificate issued by Mangalore University if the candidate is from the other state
- ◆ The selected candidates will be enrolled forthwith, on payment of the prescribed fee.
- ◆ All admissions are subject to approval from the Mangalore University.
- ◆ Here filling the application does not guarantee seat in the institutions
- ◆ Students must provide mobile numbers of self and the parents.

## Medium of Instruction

The medium of instruction is English. However, the University permits the students to write the Semester Exams in Kannada in selected subject disciplines.

## Attendance

The Mangalore University stipulates that a student who has put in less than 75% of attendance in all the subjects of study will not be eligible to write the Semester Examinations. Even if the shortage of attendance is in one subject the student will forgo all the examinations of the Semester. To become eligible he/she will have to repeat the semester.

## About Choice Based Credit Semester Scheme of Mangalore University

- ◆ Each degree program carries a certain number of Credits.
- ◆ Credits represent the weightage of a course and are a function of teaching, learning and evaluation strategies.
- ◆ 2 hours of instruction per week in a Semester carries 1 Credit.
- ◆ 1 Credit is equivalent to 50 marks.
- ◆ A three year degree program will have a maximum of 100 Credits or 104 credits.
- ◆ The degree programs are structured on Semester basis
- ◆ A part from the mandatory subjects of study students at different levels will study foundation courses, general studies and interdisciplinary subjects along with electives
- ◆ Participation of students in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities is compulsory as these are a part of the Credit Based scheme.



## STAFF

The College on its staff has competent and qualified teachers appointed on regular basis. They render dedicated service for the good of the student community and of the Institution. Their commitment finds expression in the consistently good academic track record of the Institution. The full-fledged College office is always at the service of the student body.

### Men (Formal wear)

- ❖ Dress material should be the College Uniform with the prescribed stitching pattern
- ❖ Shirts should be in formal style (half sleeves only) without any designs or trendy cuts.
- ❖ Trousers should be in formal style : full length – straight cut, and not in baggy, cargo, low-waist, pencil/carrot cut or in any other style
- ❖ The belts, if used, should be of leather, formal in style and black in color.
- ❖ Tattoos, ear-rings, pigtails, awkward bracelets, headgears, cowboyish / gypsy appearance, visors, sunglasses, etc., are banned
- ❖ Hairstyle must be formal - neat, tidy, organized, and well groomed. Hair coloring is not allowed
- ❖ Moustaches are allowed, but hair may not extend beyond the edges of the lips, nor may it extend beyond the top of the upper lip
- ❖ Beard should be neatly shaved or trimmed (it should not be longer than one-quarter centimeter in length if sported). All types of beard and moustache designs are prohibited.
- ❖ Hiking boots, cowboy boots and gaudy colored footwear are banned

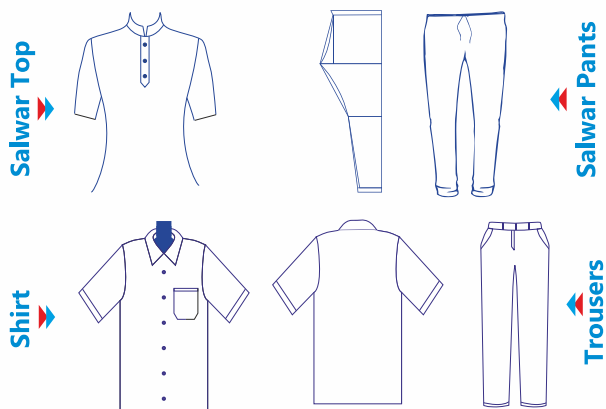
### Dress Code

All the students are required to abide by the dress code of the College whenever they are on the Campus -working days, examinations, fests, annual celebrations, special classes and EC/CC activities.

### Women (Salwar Kameez)

- ◆ Dress material should be the College Uniform with the prescribed stitching pattern
- ◆ Tops should be round in 'Nehru collar' style. Deep neck and long slit patterns are banned
- ◆ Pants should be formal. Push ups and leggings are banned.
- ◆ Stoles, short kurthas, colouring of hair, piercing of body for studding, etc. are not allowed
- ◆ Uniform should be prominently displayed. Scarves / head coverings are strictly prohibited.
- ◆ Being bedecked in huge jewelry – genuine or imitative should be avoided
- ◆ Acceptable footwear include: pumps, peep toe, open toe dress shoes, closed and open toe sling backs, open back heels, clogs, loafers, deck shoes, non-athletic walking shoes, dress boots and flats

## BAN ON CELL PHONES :

- ✓ Use of Cell phones by the students on the campus is banned. Cell phones, if found with the students will be confiscated
- ✓ Students should not play audio/visual devices in the college campus. If found, the devices will be confiscated

## BAN ON 4 WHEELERS :

- ❖ Those students who come to the college by two wheelers, should have a valid driving licence and insurance cover. To avoid noise pollution and disturbance, the vehicles should be fitted with silencers. Students should park their vehicles only in the place allotted to them. Bringing four wheelers to the college by the students is prohibited

## BAN ON USE OF TOBACCO, ALCOHOL ETC. :

- ✓ Use of tobacco, alcohol or any other intoxicants is banned in the premises.

## BAN ON RAGGING :

- ❖ Any act which results in physical or psychological harm like teasing, abusing, asking any student to do any act, which he / she would not do in the ordinary course is defined as ragging.
- ❖ Ragging is banned on the campus.
- ❖ Students should note that ragging is a cognizable criminal offence and those who indulge in it or encourage it will be handed over to the law enforcement agencies as per the orders of Supreme Court of India
- ❖ There is a Committee consisting of senior faculty members, hostel authorities etc., to keep vigil over ragging and to prevent it.

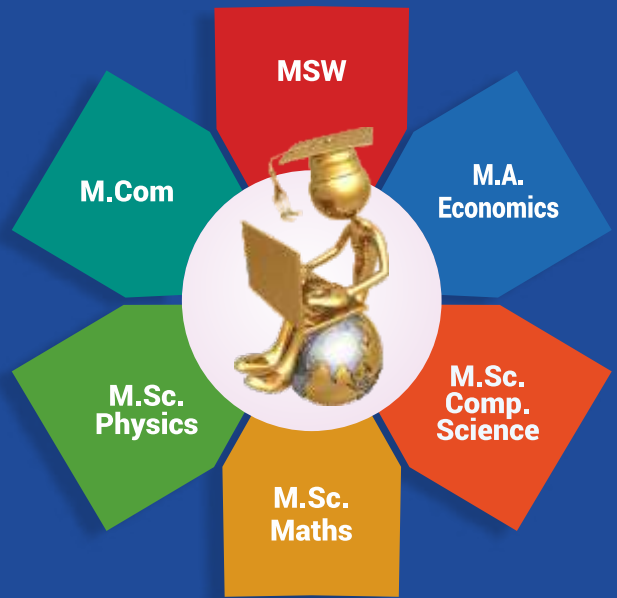
## IDENTITY CARD :

- ✓ Photo Identity Cards attested by the Principal will be issued to all the students of the College. Students have to put on the ID Cards compulsorily. 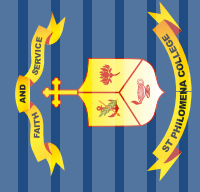


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
